

Utah FBLA-PBL Business Education Scholarship Selection Process Guidelines

The Utah Future Business Leaders of America-Phi Beta Lambda are pleased to offer the Utah FBLA-PBL Business Education Scholarship. The scholarship is designed to encourage talented FBLA graduating seniors and PBL members who plan to pursue a teaching career in business education at a Utah college or university. The scholarship is intended to help defray the cost of tuition and books.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be a U.S. Citizen.
2. Must be a legal resident of the State of Utah.
3. Must currently be a member of Utah FBLA-PBL.
4. Must currently be a senior standing at the secondary level.

SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

1. The recipient must show serious intent to enroll in an approved Utah college/university program leading to a degree in business education.
2. The application form must be received by the last Thursday in February of the year the scholarship will be presented.
3. FBLA Advisers shall mail the student's completed application to:

4. The monetary award will not be awarded until a letter verifying the student is enrolled in a college or university is received. It is the recipient's responsibility to furnish the State Assistant Director verification of official enrollment.
5. Should a recipient, for whatever reason, decide not to attend college immediately upon high school graduation, the award must be used within one year or arrangements made with the Assistant State Director.
6. The official presentation of the scholarship will be made at the annual Utah FBLA-PBL State Leadership Conference.
